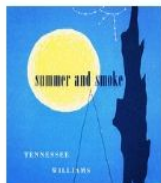

## **About the Staged Reading Series from Director Allison McDonell Page**

Sierra Classic Theatre puts on this staged reading series in order to celebrate their 20th year, to share some great plays with Mammoth audiences that they otherwise would be unable to see, and to add programming to our town as we build towards the truly exciting, cutting edge cultural facility, the MACC. I chose plays with very small casts because as Charles Isherwood of the *New York Times* put it, *“all that is required to create a potent dramatic event is two characters. Put a pair onstage, and you automatically have a relationship, and from the complicated ways in which two people relate to each other can grow myriad dramatic developments. The people up there will connect or they will conflict, and the result will be any of a number of compelling possibilities: betrayal, conciliation, destruction, erotic attraction.”*

I hope with these great actors the readings will feel like the real thing, with an extra element of collaboration as the audience is included in the process rather than a passive witness to the finished product.
