


# **About Au Lapin Agile**

The Lapin Agile is a real bar/cabaret/restaurant - in fact, one of the oldest ones in Paris. Located in the Montmartre, near the city's only remaining vineyard, this unassuming pink building became a hub for visiting bohemians in the early twentieth century, including Pablo Picasso, Toulouse Lautrec, Charlie Chaplin and Henry Miller. It's said that Picasso painted "At the Lapin Agile" to settle up his bar tab.

The cabaret was originally founded a century and a half ago and became known as "The Cabaret of Assassins" because folklore tells that the original owners were killed in a robbery attempt. After this event, the décor was updated and featured paintings of murderers lining the walls.

The next incarnation came in 1875, when the artist André Gill painted a sign for the restaurant depicting a rabbit jumping out of a skillet. Patrons began calling the establishment "Le Lapin à Gill," meaning "Gill's Rabbit." Later, this name morphed into "Cabaret au Lapin Agile" or "Cabaret of the Nimble Rabbit."

You can still visit the bar today and sit at one of the wooden tables which, over the decades, have been carved with the initials of visitors. Live musical performances are offered six nights a week. Their website says, "The Lapin Agile is the perfect definition of the artistic cabaret. Everyone, artiste and audience combine to form a company to cross the time barriers."
